## MCNEIL MANAGEMENT HOA VIOLATION AND ENFORCEMENT PROCESS

- 1. Inspection occurs, if violation(s) observed, first notice sent as appropriate.
- 2. If violation(s) persist(s) after 30 days, a second notice is sent.
- 3. If violation(s) persist(s) after 30 more days from 2<sup>nd</sup> notice, a recurring notice is sent, and the property may be placed on "The Violation Report" **OR** sent additional notices depending on circumstance and/or various factors.
- 4. Once a property has been placed on "The Violation Report" (#3), the Board of Directors decides whether the violation goes to the attorney.
- 5. Recurring Notices continue to be sent at routine intervals until compliance is achieved OR until the violation is sent to attorney.
- 6. Upon the Board of Directors voting to send the unit to the attorney, Manager sends a Final Notice granting a final 30 days to comply, along with an affidavit that, if completed and submitted, grants an additional 30 days.

## ANY TIME PRIOR TO THIS, IF THE HOMEOWNER COMPLIES, THE PROCESS IS HALTED AND VIOLATIONS ARE CLEARED.

- 7. If still no compliance after the expiration of the final notice, the matter is forwarded to the attorney who begins the legal process and sends a 20-day demand letter in keeping with FL Statutes.
- 8. If the violation persists, litigation against the property owner is begun.
